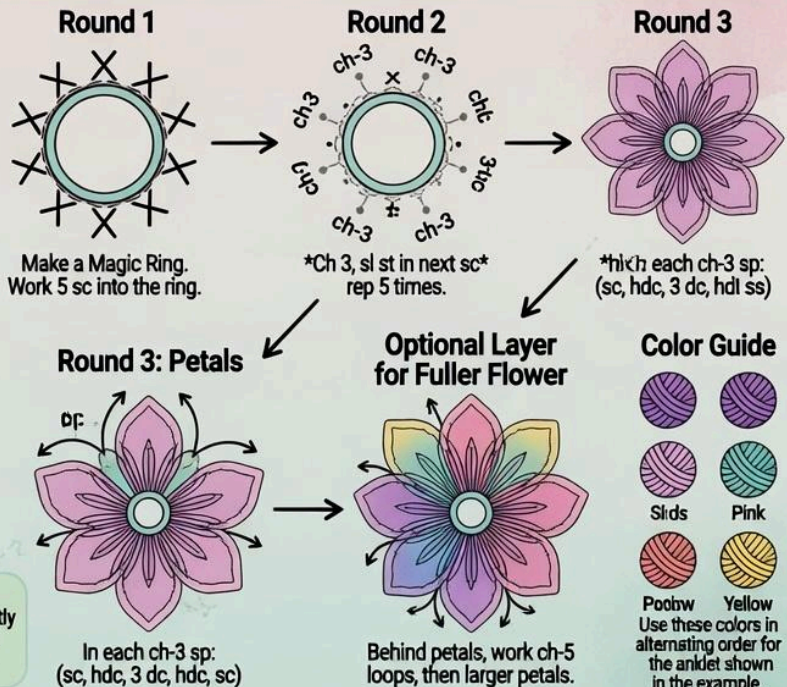
## Crochet Stitch Diagram for 5-Petal Flower Anklet

US Crochet Terms | Step-by-Step Stitch Symbols & Written Instructions

### US Crochet Stitch Symbols Legend

-  **ch = Chain:** Yarn over, pull through loop on hook.
-  **sl st = Slip Stitch:** Insert hook, yarn over, pull through both loops.
-  **sc = Single Crochet:** Insert hook, yarn over, pull up loop, yarn over, pull through 2 loops.
-  **hdc = Half Double Crochet:** Yarn over, insert hook, yarn over, pull up loop, yarn over, pull through all 3 loops.
-  **dc = Double Crochet:** Yarn over, insert hook, yarn over, pull up loop, (yarn over, pull through 2 loops) twice.
-  **Magic Ring:** Adjustable loop, pull closed firmly.

## Materials & Tools You Will Need

Before starting, gather all your materials to make the process smooth and enjoyable:

- **Yarn:** Size 8 or 10 crochet cotton thread (DMC or similar)  
Suggested colors for the rainbow effect:
    - Purple
    - Light Purple
    - Mint Green
    - Turquoise
    - Pink
    - Light Pink
    - Yellow
  - **Hook:** Steel crochet hook between **1.25 mm – 1.75 mm**

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## Finished Size & Measurements

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# Crochet Rainbow Flower Anklet Tutorial - Step by Step Guide

Easy 5-Petal Flower Anklet Bracelet | US Crochet Terms | Beginner Friendly

## Materials & Measurements

-  Yarn: Size 8 or 10 crochet cotton thread (DMC) in rainbow colors: Purple, Light Purple, Mint Green, Turquoise, Pink, Light Pink, Yellow. ~10-31 a per flower + extra for ties.
-  Hook: 1.25mm - 1.75mm steel hook (1.5mm recommended for tight stitches).
-  Other: Scissors, yarn/tapestry needle, optional small beads/pearls for centers, measuring tape.

## Finished Size

- Anklet: ~9-10 inches (23-25 cm) long excluding ties (adjustable). Each felt flower: ~1-1.5 inches (2.5-4 cm) wide. Fits most adult ankles.
- Gauge: Not critical, but work tightly for structure.

## Step-by-Step: The 5-Petal Flower

- 1. Magic Ring.** Make a magic ring (or ch 4, sl st to form ring).
  - 2. Center.** Work 5 sc into the ring. Join with sl st to first sc. Pull tight. (Optional : Add bead to center later.)
  - Step 3: First Petal Layer.** \*Ch 3, sl st in next sc\* repeat 4 more times (5 ch-3 loops).
  - Step 4: Petals.** In each ch-3 space: (sc, hdc, 3 dc, hdc, sc). Creates 5 rounded petals. Join, fasten off or continue.
  - Step 5: Optional Layer.** Behind petals, work ch-5 loops into back of round 2. In each ch-5: (sc, hdc, 5 dc, hdc, sc) for larger outer petals.
  - Step 6: Finish Flower.** Weave in ends or leave long tails for joining. Secure center bead if using.
- Repeat 5-7 times in alternating colors (Purple, Turquoise, Pink, Purple, Yellow) as seen in the example.







## Assembling the Anklet

-  1. Make a long foundation chain or use strong cotton cord (20-24 inches total).
-  2. Attach flowers side-by-side by sewing with tails or slip stitching petals. Space with 1-2 ch connectors.
-  3. Extend cord into long ties (10-12 inches each side). Add tassels or knots for decoration.
-  4. Tie around ankle with a bow. Adjust length for perfect fit.

## Tips for Success

- Keep tension even and tight.
- Count stitches carefully.
- Weave ends securely.
- Block flowers lightly for shape.

## Step 1: Create the Magic Ring

Start by forming the center of your flower.

- Wrap yarn around your fingers to create a loop
- Insert hook into the loop
- Yarn over and pull through
- Chain 1 to secure

Alternatively:

- Chain 4 and join with a slip stitch to form a ring
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## Step 2: Make the Flower Center

- Work **5 single crochet (sc)** into the magic ring
- Pull the tail tightly to close the ring completely
- Join with a **slip stitch** into the first sc

Optional:

- Add a bead or pearl in the center later for decoration
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## Step 3: Create the First Petal Layer

Now you'll build the base structure for petals:

- Chain 3
- Slip stitch into the next stitch
- Repeat this sequence **5 times total**

You should now have **5 chain-3 loops** forming a circle around the center

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## Step 4: Form the 5 Petals

Inside each chain space, work the following stitches:

- 1 single crochet (sc)
- 1 half double crochet (hdc)
- 3 double crochet (dc)
- 1 half double crochet (hdc)
- 1 single crochet (sc)

Repeat in each of the 5 chain spaces

This creates **5 rounded, soft petals** 🌻

Once finished:

- Join with a slip stitch
  - Fasten off OR continue to next step
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## **Step 5: Optional Second Layer (Fuller Flower)**

To create a more dimensional flower:

- Turn the flower slightly to access the back loops
- Behind the petals, work **chain 5 loops** between stitches

In each loop, crochet:

- 1 sc
- 1 hdc
- 5 dc
- 1 hdc
- 1 sc

This creates **larger outer petals**, making your flower fuller and more vibrant 🌸 ✨

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## **Step 6: Finish the Flower**

- Fasten off yarn
  - Use a tapestry needle to weave in ends securely
  - If desired, sew a bead or pearl into the center
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## **Step 7: Make Multiple Flowers**

Repeat the entire process **5 to 7 times** using different colors:

Suggested sequence:

- Purple
- Turquoise
- Pink
- Light Purple
- Yellow

This creates the beautiful rainbow effect 

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## **Step 8: Create the Anklet Base**

You have two options:

### **Option 1: Chain Base**

- Chain a length of **20–24 inches (50–60 cm)**

### **Option 2: Cord Base**

- Use strong cotton thread or cord instead of chaining
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## **Step 9: Attach the Flowers**

- Arrange flowers side-by-side
- Sew them together using yarn tails or whip stitch
- Leave small gaps (1–2 chains) between flowers if desired

Make sure they are aligned evenly for a clean look

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## Step 10: Add Ties

- Extend both ends of the anklet with:
  - Chains (10–12 inches each side), OR
  - Yarn strands for tying

Optional:

- Add tassels or small knots at the ends for decoration
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## Step 11: Wear and Adjust

- Wrap around your ankle
  - Tie into a bow 
  - Adjust for comfort and fit
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## Tips for Best Results

- Keep your tension **even and tight**
  - Count stitches carefully to maintain symmetry
  - Weave in ends securely for durability
  - Lightly block flowers to improve shape
