



CROCHET CAT FACE

WITH FLOWER CROWN

STEP-BY-STEP TUTORIAL

A sweet and easy project perfect for coasters, appliques, or decorative pieces! ♥

ABBREVIATIONS (US TERMS)

- ch = chain
- sl st = slip stitch
- sc = single crochet
- hdc = half double crochet
- dc = double crochet
- tr = treble crochet
- inc = increase (2 sts in same st)
- dec = decrease (2 sts together)
- st(s) = stitch(es)
- () = work in the same stitch
- ** = repeat instructions between **

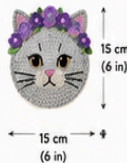


NOTES

- ♥ Use stitch markers to mark the first stitch of each round.
- ♥ Work in continuous rounds unless otherwise stated.
- ♥ Stuff lightly if you want a puffy look, or leave flat.

FINISHED SIZE

Approx.
15 cm (6 in)
diameter



MATERIALS

- Worsted weight yarn:
 - Gray (main)
 - Light gray (muzzle & border)
 - Pink (nose & flowers)
 - Purple (flowers)
 - Light pink (ear centers)
 - Green (leaves)
 - Beige (flower centers)
 - Black (eyes & whiskers)
 - Gold or tan (eye detail)
- 4.0 mm (G/6) crochet hook
- Yarn needle
- Scissors

TOOLS

- Scissors
- Yarn needle
- Stitch markers
- Measuring tape

BASIC STITCHES



FACE PIECES (MAKE EACH)

STEP-BY-STEP INSTRUCTIONS

1. HEAD (GRAY)



R1: 6 sc in magic ring (6)
R2: inc around (12) B
R3: (sc, inc) around (18)
R4: (2 sc, inc) around (24)
R5: (3 sc, inc) around (30)
R6: (4 sc, inc) around (36)
R7: (5 sc, inc) around (42)
R8: (6 sc, inc) around (48)
R9-R10: sc around (48) B
Fasten off.

2. MUZZLE (LIGHT GRAY)



Make 2.
R1: 6 sc in magic ring (6)
R2: (sc, inc) around (9)
R3: sc around (9)
Fasten off, leave long tail for sewing.

3. INNER EARS (LIGHT PINK)



Make 2.
R1: 3 sc in magic ring (3)
R2: inc, sc, inc (5)
R3: sc across (5)
Fasten off.

4. NOSE (PINK)



R1: 3 sc in magic ring (3)
R2: inc, sc (4)
R3: dec, sc (3)
Fasten off, leave long tail.

5. EYES (MAKE 2)



With black:
R1: 6 sc in magic ring (6)
Change to gold/tan. B
R2: sc around (6)
Fasten off.

6. FLOWERS



R1: 5 ch, sl st to first ch to form a ring.
R2: (ch 3, 2 dc, ch 3, sl st) in ring, repeat 5 times.
Fasten off.
Make 2 pink and 2 purple.

7. LEAVES



Ch 6.
Row 1: sl st in 2nd ch from hook, sc, hdc, dc, hdc, sc (5 sts).
Fasten off.
Make 4 leaves.

8. ASSEMBLE EARS



Place pink inner ear inside gray ear top.
Sew or slip stitch in place.
Attach ears to the top of the head.

9. ATTACH MUZZLE



Sew the two light gray muzzle pieces on the lower center of the face.

10. ADD NOSE & EMBROIDER



Sew the pink nose in the center top of the muzzle.
Embroider mouth and whiskers with black yarn.

11. ADD EYES



Sew the eyes above the muzzle.
Embroider eyebrows (optional).

12. FLOWER CROWN



Arrange flowers and leaves along the top of the head.
Sew or slip stitch with piece securely.
Add beige centers to the flowers.

13. BORDER (LIGHT GRAY)



Attach light gray yarn.
R1: sl st evenly around the entire piece.
R2: sc around.
Fasten off and weave in ends.
Your cat face is ready! ♥

TIPS FOR SUCCESS

- ♥ Keep your tension even.
- ♥ Use stitch markers to track rounds.
- ♥ Sew pieces securely so they don't come loose.
- ♥ Block gently for a neat, flat finish.



IDEAS & VARIATIONS

- ♥ Make it bigger by using bulky yarn and a larger hook.
- ♥ Add a keychain ring or pin back.
- ♥ Use different flower colors for each season.



CARE INSTRUCTIONS

- Hand wash gently in cold water.
- Lay flat to dry.
- Do not bleach.
- Do not wring.
- Iron on low if needed.

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Crochet Cat Face

Create an adorable crochet cat face decorated with a colorful flower crown. This charming project can be used as a coaster, wall decoration, appliqué, nursery decoration, gift, or bag embellishment. The finished piece measures approximately **6 inches (15 cm)** across and is worked in separate pieces that are assembled together.

Finished Size

- Diameter: Approximately 6 inches (15 cm)
- Thickness: Flat appliqué style

Skill Level

- Beginner to Intermediate

Materials

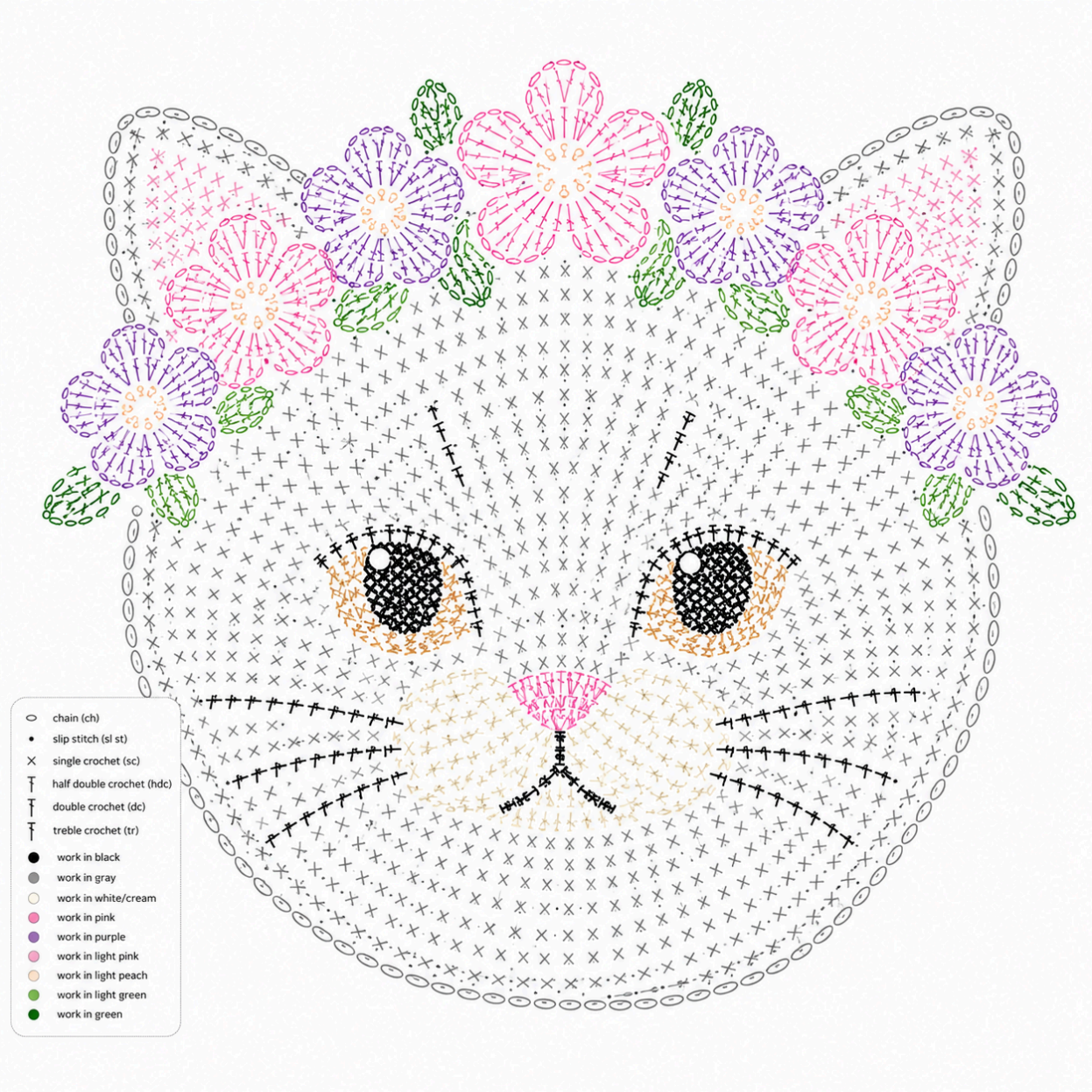
Yarn Colors

- Gray (main cat face)
- Light gray (muzzle)
- Pink (nose and inner ears)
- Black (eyes and whiskers)
- Gold or mustard (eye outline)
- Purple (flowers)
- Pink (flowers)
- Green (leaves)

Supplies

- 4.0 mm (G/6) crochet hook
- Yarn needle
- Scissors
- Stitch markers
- Fabric glue (optional)

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- dec = decrease
- st = stitch

Step 1: Crochet the Cat Head

The head forms the base of the project.

Round 1

Make a magic ring.

Work:

- 6 sc into ring

Pull tight.

(6 sts)

Round 2

Work 2 sc in each stitch.

(12 sts)

Round 3

1 sc, inc

Repeat around.

(18 sts)

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Round 4

2 sc, inc

Repeat around.

(24 sts)

Round 5

3 sc, inc

Repeat around.

(30 sts)

Round 6

4 sc, inc

Repeat around.

(36 sts)

Round 7

5 sc, inc

Repeat around.

(42 sts)

Round 8

6 sc, inc

Repeat around.

(48 sts)

Fasten off.

The circle should measure approximately:

- 5 inches (12–13 cm)

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Step 2: Crochet the Muzzle Pieces

Make two identical circles.

Round 1

Magic ring.

6 sc in ring.

Round 2

Increase around.

(12 sts)

Round 3

1 sc, inc

Repeat around.

(18 sts)

Fasten off leaving a long tail.

Each muzzle circle should measure:

- 1.25 inches (3 cm)

Make 2.

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Step 3: Crochet the Inner Ears

Make 2 using pink yarn.

Row 1

Ch 3.

Work:

- 1 sc
- 1 hdc
- 3 dc in last chain

Continue on opposite side:

- 1 hdc
- 1 sc

Fasten off.

Ear height:

- About 1 inch (2.5 cm)

Step 4: Crochet the Outer Ears

Using gray yarn.

Row 1

Ch 4.

Row 2

Work:

- sc
- hdc
- dc
- 4 dc in last stitch

Continue down opposite side.

Fasten off.

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Attach pink ear centers to gray ears.

Step 5: Crochet the Nose

Using pink yarn.

Round 1

Magic ring.

Work:

- 3 sc

Turn.

Round 2

Increase across.

Round 3

Sc around edges forming a small triangle.

Fasten off.

Finished size:

- About $\frac{3}{4}$ inch (2 cm)

Step 6: Crochet the Eyes

Make 2.

Pupil

Using black yarn:

Magic ring.

6 sc in ring.

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Eye Outline

Using gold yarn:

Work 2 sc in each stitch.

Fasten off.

Finished eye diameter:

- Approximately 1 inch (2.5 cm)

Step 7: Crochet the Leaves

Make 6–8 leaves.

Using green yarn.

Row 1

Ch 6.

Work along chain:

- sc
- hdc
- dc
- hdc
- sc

Work opposite side.

Sl st to finish.

Fasten off.

Each leaf should measure:

- 1¼ inches (3 cm)

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Step 8: Crochet the Flowers

Make approximately:

- 3 pink flowers
- 3 purple flowers

Flower Center

Magic ring.

6 sc.

Join.

Petals

In each stitch:

(sc, hdc, dc, hdc, sc)

Repeat around.

Fasten off.

Finished flower size:

- 1¼ inches (3 cm)

Step 9: Attach the Ears

Position ears at the top of the head.

Placement:

- Approximately 1 inch (2.5 cm) apart

Sew securely.

Slightly angle them outward for a realistic appearance.

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Step 10: Attach the Muzzle

Position the two muzzle circles.

Overlap slightly in the center.

Place:

- About 1 inch (2.5 cm) from the bottom edge

Sew securely.

Step 11: Attach the Nose

Center the nose over the overlap of the muzzle circles.

Sew firmly.

Step 12: Embroider the Mouth

Using black yarn:

Create a short vertical line beneath the nose.

Add:

- Two curved smile lines

Keep stitches neat and symmetrical.

Step 13: Attach the Eyes

Position eyes:

- Approximately 1 inch (2.5 cm) above muzzle

Space between eyes:

- About 1 inch (2.5 cm)

Sew securely.

Step 14: Embroider Eyelashes

Using black yarn.

Add:

- 3–4 short stitches above each eye

This gives the cat a sweet expression.

Step 15: Add Whiskers

Using black yarn.

Create:

- 3 whiskers on each side

Length:

- About 1.5 inches (4 cm)

Keep them evenly spaced.

Step 16: Create the Flower Crown

Arrange flowers along the top of the head.

Suggested layout:

- Purple flower
- Pink flower
- Purple flower
- Pink flower
- Purple flower
- Pink flower

Insert green leaves between flowers.

Experiment before sewing.

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Step 17: Attach the Flower Crown

Sew flowers one at a time.

Work from center outward.

Attach leaves underneath flowers.

Make sure the crown follows the curve of the head.

Step 18: Add Decorative Border (Optional)

Using light gray yarn.

Attach yarn anywhere around edge.

Border Round

Work:

- 1 sc in every stitch

Join with sl st.

For a decorative edge:

(sc, ch 1) around.

Fasten off.

Step 19: Weave in Ends

Check the back carefully.

Secure:

- Flower tails
- Ear tails
- Muzzle tails
- Border yarn

Trim excess yarn.

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Step 20: Block the Finished Piece

Lightly spray with water.

Pin flat.

Shape ears and flowers.

Allow to dry completely.

Finished Measurements

Cat Face

- Diameter: 6 inches (15 cm)

Flowers

- Diameter: 1¼ inches (3 cm)

Leaves

- Length: 1¼ inches (3 cm)

Ears

- Height: 1 inch (2.5 cm)

Creative Uses

- ✿ Mug coaster
- ✿ Wall hanging
- ✿ Nursery decoration
- ✿ Tote bag appliqué
- ✿ Pillow embellishment
- ✿ Gift topper
- ✿ Scrapbook decoration

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Care Instructions

- Hand wash only
- Cold water
- Do not bleach
- Lay flat to dry
- Do not wring
- Steam lightly if needed

Final Result
