STEP-BY-STEP TUTORIAL

A lightweight and feminine shawl,
perfect for summer days and cool evenings. ♥

SIZE

One size
Width (top): 140 cm
(55 in)
Length (center):
70 cm
(27.5 in)
Adjust the length
by adding or
removing rows.

MATERIALS

- Cotton yarn (DK weight)
approx. 350 g / 780 yd
- Crochet hook 4.0 mm (G)
- Yarn needle
- Scissors
- Stitch markers (optional)

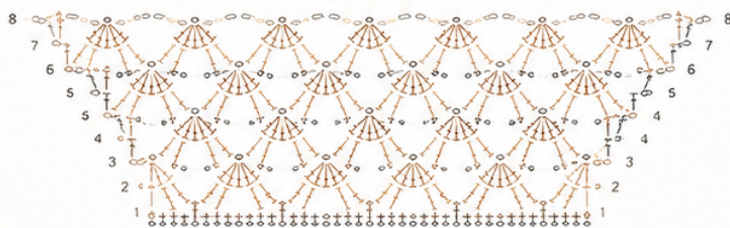

Foundation: multiple of 14 + 3 chains

STITCH KEY

○ = chain (ch)
+ = single crochet (sc)
T = double crochet (dc)
T = treble crochet (tr)
— = slip stitch (sl st)
() = work in same stitch
--- = space (sp)

POM-POM FRINGE

Make small pom-poms
and attach along the
edges.
Make 2 pom-poms at
the tip and use them
as ties.



♥ STEP-BY-STEP ♥

1 FOUNDATION



Ch a multiple of 14 + 3.
Example: ch 59.

2 ROW 1



1 dc in 4th ch from hook,
* ch 2, skip 2 sts,
4 dc in next ch;
repeat from * to last 2 sts,
ch 2, skip 2 sts, 1 dc
in last ch.

3 ROW 2



Ch 3 (counts as tr).
1 tr in same st.
* ch 2, 5 tr in ch-2 sp;
repeat from * to last sp,
ch 2, 2 tr in top of
turning ch.

4 ROW 3



Ch 3, 1 tr in same st.
* ch 2, 5 tr in ch-2 sp;
repeat from * to last sp,
ch 2, 2 tr in top of
turning ch.
Repeat Row 3 until
desired length.

5 EDGES



Work 1 sc evenly along
the top edge.
Work 1 sc, ch 3, 1 sc
in each side edge row.

6 POM-POM



Make pom-poms
(approx. 2-2.5 cm /
0.8-1 in).
Attach one pom-pom
in each ch-3 space
along the edges.

7 TIES



Make two cords.
Attach a pom-pom
at each end.
Sew the cords at
the bottom tip.

8 DONE!

TIPS FOR SUCCESS

- Use a soft, breathable
cotton yarn.
- Keep your tension even
for a neat lace pattern.
- Block your shawl lightly
for the best shape.



IDEAS & VARIATIONS

- Use a gradient or variegated
yarn for a stunning effect.
- Add beads between
pom-poms.
- Make it longer by adding
more rows.



CARE INSTRUCTIONS

- Hand wash gently
in cold water.
- Lay flat to dry.
- Do not bleach.
- Do not iron.

Crochet Boho Summer Shawl

The **Crochet Boho Summer Shawl** is a lightweight triangular lace shawl featuring an airy openwork pattern, delicate edging, and decorative pom-pom ties. Designed for warm-weather layering, this elegant accessory is perfect for beach vacations, summer evenings, festivals, and casual outfits. Because it is worked from the top down, you can easily adjust the size by adding or removing pattern repeats.

Skill Level

Intermediate

This project is ideal for crocheters familiar with lace stitches, chain spaces, double crochet, treble crochet, and repeating stitch patterns.

Finished Size

Approximate finished measurements:

- Width: 140 cm (55 in)
- Center Length: 70 cm (27.5 in)

The size can be customized by continuing additional pattern repeats.

Materials

- 350 g (780 yd) DK weight cotton yarn
- 4.0 mm (G) crochet hook
- Yarn needle
- Scissors
- Stitch markers (optional)
- Cardboard pom-pom maker or pom-pom tool (optional)

Crochet Abbreviations (US Terms)

- ch = chain
- sl st = slip stitch
- sc = single crochet
- dc = double crochet
- tr = treble crochet
- sp = chain space
- st = stitch
- rep = repeat
- sk = skip
- FO = fasten off

Gauge

Gauge is not critical for this project, but maintaining even tension will ensure the lace motifs remain consistent and symmetrical.

Foundation Chain

Begin by chaining a multiple of **14 + 3 stitches**.

The additional three chains serve as the turning chain for the first row.

Row 1

Work one double crochet into the fourth chain from the hook. Chain two, skip two chains, then work four double crochets into the next chain space. Continue repeating this sequence across the foundation chain. Finish the row with one double crochet in the last chain and turn your work.

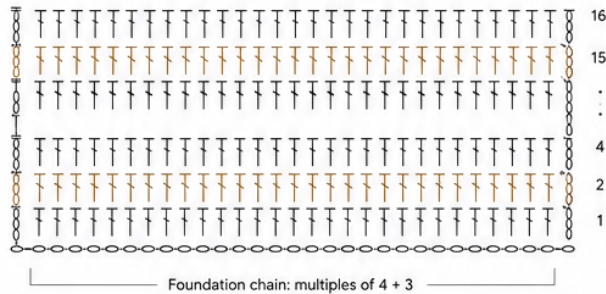
Row 2

Chain three to count as the first treble crochet. Work one treble crochet into the same stitch, chain two, then work five treble crochets into the next chain-two space. Continue repeating the lace sequence across the row, ending with two treble crochets in the final stitch. Turn.

LACE TRIANGLE PONCHO

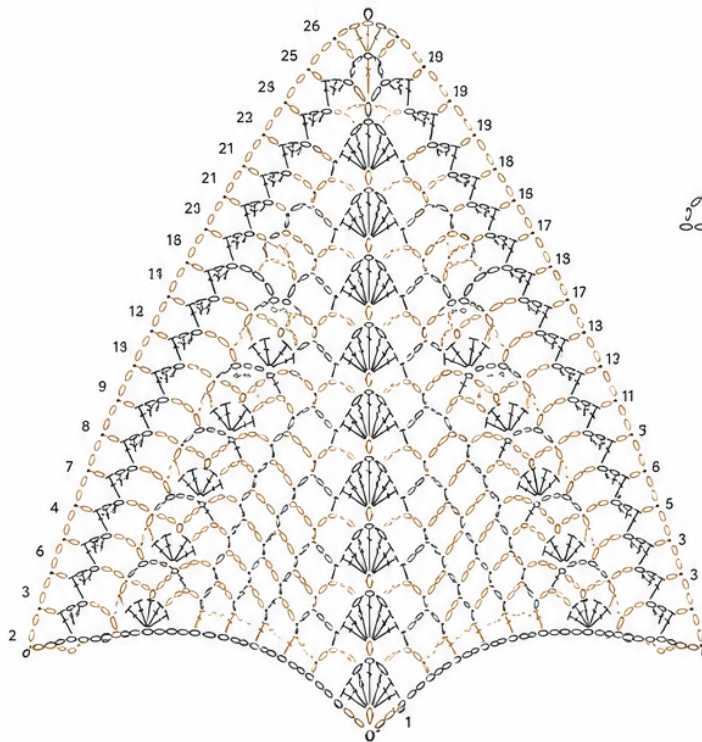
1. UPPER BACK PANEL (RECTANGLE)



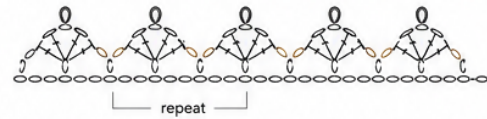
LEGEND (STITCHES)

3. SHELL STITCH (EDGE PATTERN)



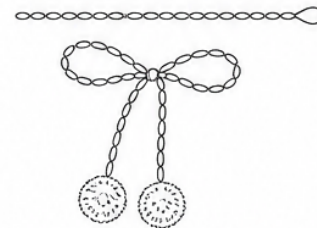

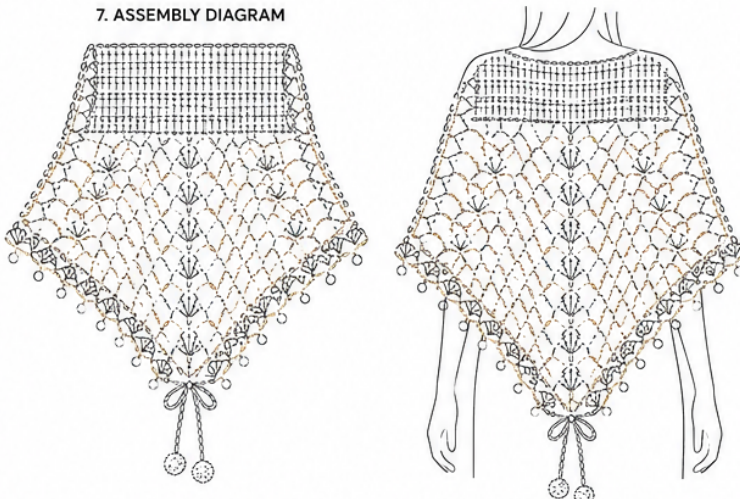
5. FINISHING BORDER (ALL AROUND)

NOTES

- Start with the upper back panel (rectangle).
- Continue working the triangle body from the bottom of the panel.
- Work the shell stitch border around the entire poncho.
- Make tie cords and attach pompoms to the front tip.

Row 3

Chain three and work one treble crochet into the first stitch. Continue by working chain-two spaces followed by lace shell groups into every chain space from the previous row. Keep the increases balanced on both sides so the triangular shape grows evenly.

Repeat Rows

Continue repeating the established lace pattern, increasing evenly along both edges with each row. The shawl naturally widens while maintaining its triangular shape. Repeat until the center length measures approximately 70 cm (27.5 inches), or continue longer for a larger wrap.

Top Edge

After reaching the desired size, work one complete row of single crochet evenly across the top edge. This strengthens the neckline and gives the shawl a neat, finished appearance.

Side Edging

Work one round of single crochet along both angled sides. If desired, add small picots by working **chain three, slip stitch into the first chain** every few stitches to create a delicate decorative border.

Pom-Pom Fringe

Create small pom-poms measuring approximately 2–2.5 cm (0.8–1 inch) in diameter. Attach one pom-pom to each decorative point along the lower edge. Make two additional pom-poms for the tie cords located at the bottom point of the shawl.

Tie Cords

Crochet or braid two cords approximately 30–35 cm (12–14 inches) long. Attach one pom-pom to each end and securely fasten the cords to the bottom point of the shawl.

Blocking

After weaving in all loose ends, gently wet block or steam block the shawl. Pin the lace open to fully display the stitch pattern and allow it to dry completely before wearing.

Customization Ideas

Experiment with gradient yarns for a soft color transition or choose variegated cotton yarn for a unique boho effect. Glass beads or wooden beads can be added along the edging for extra texture. The shawl can also be made oversized by simply continuing additional lace repeats.

Helpful Tips

Maintain consistent stitch tension throughout the project so the lace motifs remain even. Count stitches regularly, especially after completing each repeat. Blocking is highly recommended because it dramatically improves the definition of the lace pattern. Lightweight cotton yarn offers excellent stitch definition and comfortable wear during warmer months.

Care Instructions

Hand wash using cool water and a mild detergent. Avoid bleach and harsh chemicals. Gently squeeze out excess water without wringing, then lay the shawl flat on a towel to dry. Light steaming can be used to refresh the lace after storage.

Perfect For

This elegant shawl is ideal for summer dresses, beach cover-ups, weddings, outdoor events, festivals, evening walks, vacations, handmade gifts, and lightweight layering throughout spring and summer.
