STEP-BY-STEP TUTORIAL

A delicate and beautiful lace pattern
perfect for scarves, tops, table runners
and more!

FINISHED SIZE

One repeat =
14 chains (14 sts)
in width

The height is
made by repeating
Rows 2-4.



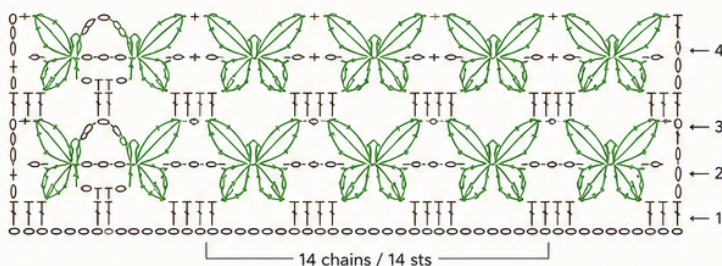
MATERIALS

- Cotton yarn
(sport or DK weight)
- Crochet hook
suitable for your yarn
- Scissors
- Yarn needle

ABBREVIATIONS (US TERMS)

ch	= chain
sc	= single crochet
hdc	= half double crochet
dc	= double crochet
tr	= treble crochet
sp	= space
st(s)	= stitch(es)
*	= repeat
()	= work in same stitch

♥ STEP-BY-STEP ♥

1. FOUNDATION



Ch 14 (multiple of 14
chains + 1 for turning).
Row 1: Work sc in the
2nd chain from hook
and in each chain
across.

2. ROW 2



Ch 5 (counts as dc + ch 2),
skip 2 sts, *4 tr together
in next st, ch 2, skip 2 sts,
sc in next st*; repeat from
* to * across.

3. ROW 3



Ch 3 (counts as dc),
*dc in next ch-2 sp,
ch 3*; repeat from * to *
across, end with dc in
the last sc.

4. ROW 4



Ch 1, sc in same st,
*ch 2, 4 tr together in
next ch-3 sp, ch 2, sc in
next dc*; repeat from *
to * across.

5. REPEAT



Repeat Rows 3 and 4
for pattern until you
reach your desired
length.

6. FINISH



Fasten off and weave
in all ends. Block lightly
for an even and
beautiful lace.

TIPS FOR SUCCESS

- ♥ Use a smooth, light yarn to
highlight the lace pattern.
- ♥ Keep your tension even
for a neat result.
- ♥ Blocking helps open up
the spaces and define
the butterflies.



IDEAS & VARIATIONS

- ♥ Try this pattern with
cotton thread for a
more delicate look.
- ♥ Great for shawls, wraps,
blouses, or home décor.
- ♥ Change colors to create
stripes or ombré effects.



CARE INSTRUCTIONS

- Hand wash gently
with mild soap.
- Lay flat to dry.
- Do not bleach.
- Do not iron.

Crochet Butterfly Stitch Pattern

The **Crochet Butterfly Stich Pattern** is a delicate lace design featuring elegant butterfly motifs connected by airy stitches. This beautiful pattern is perfect for scarves, shawls, table runners, curtains, lightweight garments, and decorative home accessories. Because the pattern is built from repeating sections, it can easily be customized to virtually any size.

Skill Level

Intermediate

This project is suitable for crocheters who are comfortable working with chain spaces, treble crochet stitches, and repeated lace motifs.

Finished Size

Each butterfly repeat measures approximately 14 foundation chains in width and 4 working rows in height. Continue repeating the pattern until reaching your desired dimensions.

Materials

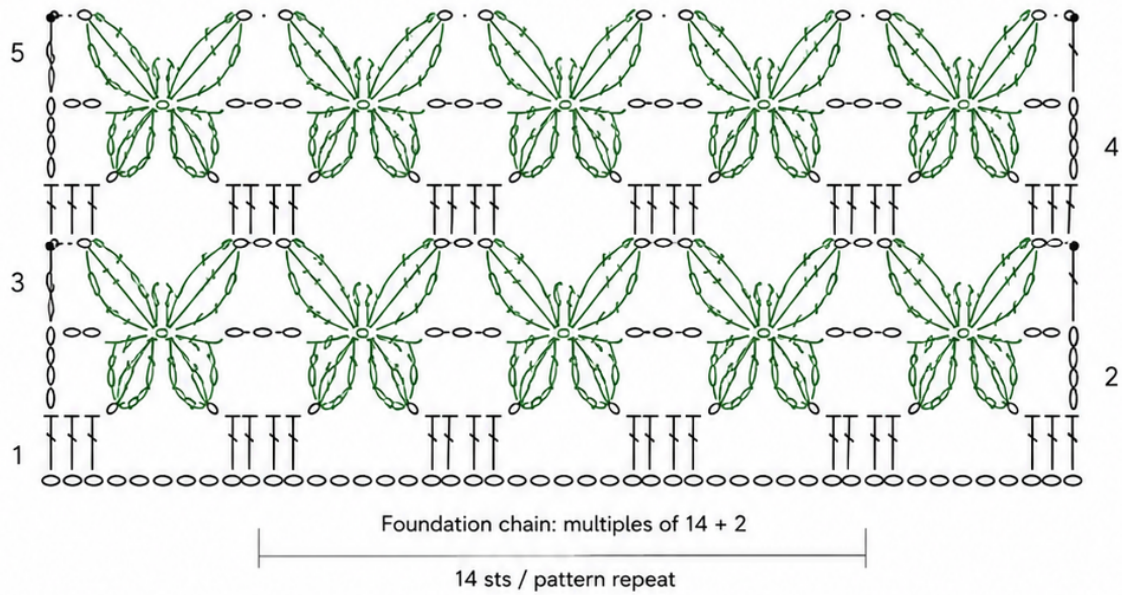
- Sport or DK weight cotton yarn
- 3.0–3.5 mm crochet hook
- Scissors
- Yarn needle
- Stitch markers (optional)

Crochet Abbreviations (US Terms)

- ch = chain
- sl st = slip stitch
- sc = single crochet
- hdc = half double crochet
- dc = double crochet
- tr = treble crochet
- sp = chain space
- st = stitch
- rep = repeat
- sk = skip
- FO = fasten off

CROCHET PATTERN DIAGRAM

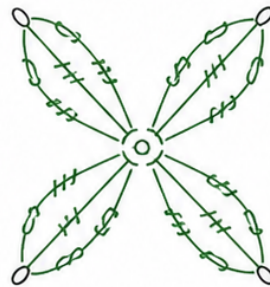
BUTTERFLY LACE STITCH



LEGEND (STITCHES)

- = Chain (ch)
- +
- ⌏ = Single crochet (sc)
- ⌏ = Half double crochet (hdc)
- ⌏ = Double crochet (dc)
-  = 4 double crochet butterfly

BUTTERFLY (4 DOUBLE CROCHET)



NOTES

- Make a foundation chain in multiples of 14 + 2.
- Row 1: Work the foundation chain, then work half double crochet (hdc) as shown.
- Row 2: Work butterflies (4 double crochet) separated by chain spaces.
- Row 3: Work chain spaces and half double crochet to create the mesh.
- Repeat Rows 2-5 for the desired length.

Foundation Chain

Chain a multiple of **14 + 1** for turning. This allows each butterfly motif to repeat evenly across the panel.

Row 1

Beginning in the second chain from the hook, work one single crochet in every chain across the foundation. Turn your work.

Row 2

Chain 5 to count as one double crochet and a chain-two space. Skip two stitches and work a four-treble cluster. Chain two and continue repeating this sequence across the row. Finish with one double crochet in the final stitch.

Row 3

Chain three and work into each chain space created in the previous row. Form another butterfly cluster followed by chain-two spaces all the way across. End with one double crochet.

Row 4

Chain one and work one single crochet, followed by chain-two spaces and butterfly clusters across the row. This joins the motifs while maintaining the lace structure.

Repeat

Repeat Rows 3 and 4 until your project reaches the desired length. Each repeat adds another row of butterfly motifs.

Finishing

Fasten off the yarn and weave in all loose ends with a yarn needle. Wet block or steam block the finished lace panel to fully open the butterfly motifs and create a smooth, professional finish.

Project Ideas

This lace panel can be transformed into elegant scarves, shawls, table runners, curtains, decorative pillow covers, baby blankets, summer tops, cardigan inserts, beach cover-ups, tote bag panels, and many other lightweight crochet projects.

Helpful Tips

Maintain even tension throughout the project to keep each butterfly identical. Cotton yarn provides the best stitch definition for lace work. Using stitch markers at the beginning of each repeat can help maintain perfect alignment. Blocking is highly recommended to showcase the openwork design.

Care Instructions

Hand wash in cool water using a mild detergent. Do not bleach. Lay flat to dry and avoid hanging the finished lace to preserve its shape. Steam lightly if needed after drying.
