FINISHED SIZE	MATERIALS	TOOLS	YOU WILL MAKE
Height: 18 cm (7 in) Width: 16 cm (6.3 in) Depth: 4.5 cm (1.8 in) Strap length (with ring): 20 cm (7.9 in)	- Worsted weight cotton yarn (approx. 100 g / 110 yd) in Pink 3.5 mm (E) crochet hook - Metal ring 3 cm (1.2 in) diameter - Yarn needle - Scissors - Stitch marker (optional)	3.5 mm (E) crochet hook - Scissors - Yarn needle - Stitch marker (optional) - Measuring tape	A crochet car organizer with a front heart applique, strap and metal ring to hang on your car and keep your belongings organized and within reach.

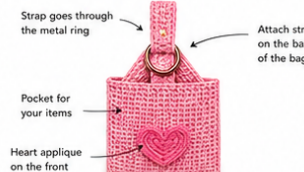
STRAP (make 1)



STITCH GUIDE (US TERMS)

ch = chain
 sl st = slip stitch
 sc = single crochet
 hdc = half double crochet
 dc = double crochet
 sts = stitches
 () = work in same stitch
 * * = repeat
 [] = repeat the instructions inside the brackets

ASSEMBLY OVERVIEW



♥ STEP-BY-STEP ♥

1. FRONT & BACK



Make 2 identical rectangles. Work in rows of single crochet until you reach the desired size.

2. SIDES & BOTTOM



Make a long strip for the sides and bottom. The length should match the perimeter of the front/back panel.

3. JOIN SIDES



Attach the strip to one front panel using single crochet. Work around the sides and bottom.

4. ATTACH BACK



Place the second panel on the back and join all edges together with single crochet.

5. MAKE STRAP



Crochet single crochet rows for the strap. Fold the strap in half and secure it.

6. ADD RING



Pass the strap through the metal ring and fold it back.

9. BOOFTONE



Your car strap to the back of the organizer securely.

TIPS FOR SUCCESS

- ★ Use a tight tension for a sturdy and durable organizer.
- ★ Count your stitches to keep the edges even.
- ★ Reinforce the strap attachment for extra safety.

IDEAS & VARIATIONS

- ♥ Try different colors to match your car interior.
- ♥ Add a button or snap closure.
- ♥ Make a smaller version for the back seat!

CARE INSTRUCTIONS

- 🧺 Hand wash gently with mild soap.
- 📏 Lay flat to dry.
- 🚫 Do not bleach.
- 🚫 Do not iron.

Keep your vehicle neat and stylish with this practical **Crochet Car Seat Organizer**. Designed to hang securely from the back of a car seat using a sturdy strap and metal ring, this organizer features a roomy pocket and a beautiful raised heart appliqué. It is perfect for holding your phone, sunglasses, charging cables, tissues, wallets, toys, or other travel essentials. This detailed tutorial explains every step so crocheters can confidently complete the project from start to finish.

Finished Measurements

Finished organizer measures approximately:

- Height (Pocket): 7 in (18 cm)
- Width: 6¼ in (16 cm)
- Depth: 1¾ in (4.5 cm)
- Hanging Strap Length: 16 in (40 cm)
- Strap Width: 2 in (5 cm)
- Metal Ring Diameter: 1¼ in (3 cm)

The measurements can easily be adjusted to create a larger organizer if desired.

Skill Level

Easy to Intermediate

Perfect for crocheters familiar with basic stitches and simple assembly.

Materials

- Cotton macramé cord or bulky cotton yarn (#6)
- Main Color: Soft Pink – approximately 220 g
- Accent Pink for heart – approximately 25 g
- 3.5 mm (E-4) crochet hook
- Yarn needle
- Stitch markers
- Scissors
- 1 metal D-ring or round ring (1¼ in / 3 cm diameter)
- Measuring tape

Crochet Abbreviations (US Terms)

- ch – chain
- sl st – slip stitch
- sc – single crochet
- hdc – half double crochet
- BLO – back loop only
- st – stitch
- inc – increase
- dec – decrease
- FO – fasten off

Gauge

14 sc × 16 rows = 4 x 4 inches (10 x 10 cm)

Gauge is not critical but maintaining consistent tension helps create a sturdy organizer.

Step 1 – Crochet the Front Panel

The front panel forms the main pocket front.

Foundation

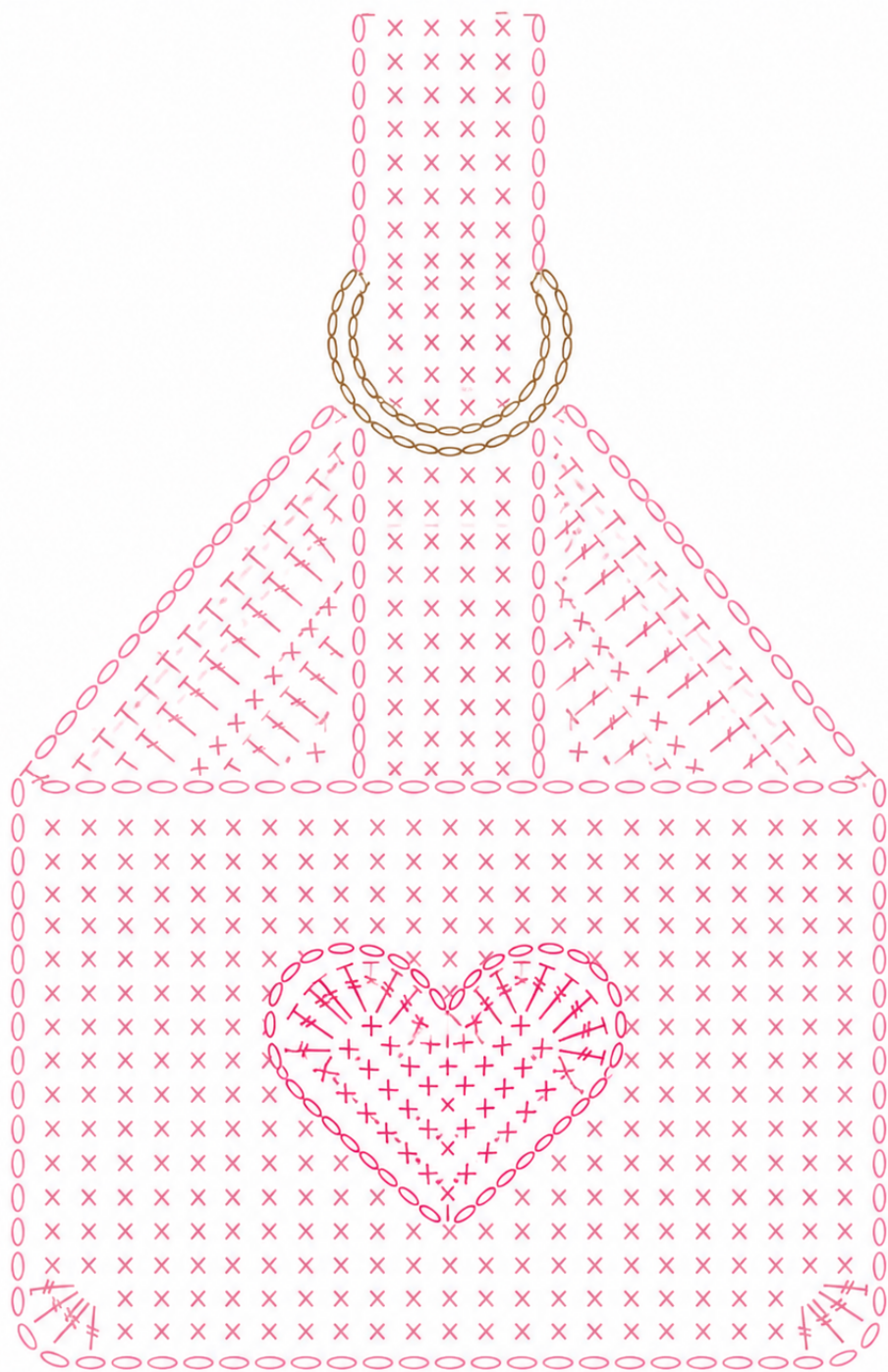
Chain 27.

Row 1

Beginning in the second chain from the hook:

Work 26 sc.

Turn.



Rows 2–28

Chain 1.

Work one sc into every stitch.

Turn.

Continue until the panel measures:

- Width: 6¼ inches (16 cm)
- Height: 7 inches (18 cm)

Fasten off.

Set aside.

Step 2 – Crochet the Back Panel

Repeat exactly as the front panel.

Make one identical rectangle.

Both panels should have matching dimensions.

Do not join them yet.

Step 3 – Crochet the Side and Bottom Strip

This strip creates the organizer depth.

Foundation

Chain 9.

Row 1

Work 8 sc.

Turn.

Continue rows until the strip measures approximately:

20 inches (50 cm)

This length wraps around:

- Left side
- Bottom
- Right side

Check the fit by pinning around the front panel before fastening off.

Adjust if necessary.

Step 4 – Assemble the Pocket

Using the yarn needle or crochet hook:

Align:

- Front panel
- Side strip

Beginning at one upper corner:

Join using single crochet or whip stitch.

Continue around:

- Left side
- Bottom
- Right side

Attach the back panel in the same way.

Leave the top completely open.

Check that all corners are square.

The organizer should now have a neat box shape.

Step 5 – Reinforce the Top Edge

Attach yarn at one upper corner.

Work one complete round of single crochet around the pocket opening.

For additional durability:

Work one more round in Back Loop Only.

This creates a firm edge that resists stretching.

Fasten off.

Step 6 – Crochet the Hanging Strap

Foundation

Chain 9.

Row 1

Work 8 sc.

Turn.

Continue working rows until the strap measures:

16 inches (40 cm)

Fold one end around the metal ring.

Overlap approximately:

2 inches (5 cm)

Sew securely using strong stitches.

The finished strap should slide smoothly over a vehicle headrest.

Step 7 – Attach the Strap

Locate the exact center of the back panel.

Pin the strap in place.

Using matching yarn:

Sew across the width several times.

Add an "X" reinforcement inside a stitched square for maximum strength.

Since this organizer may carry weight, reinforce the attachment well.

Step 8 – Crochet the Puffy Heart Appliqué

Foundation

Make a Magic Ring.

Round 1

Work:

8 sc.

Join.

Round 2

Increase evenly to 16 stitches.

Round 3

Shape the upper curves by working:

- hdc
- dc
- tr
- dc
- hdc

on each side.

Create the bottom point using decreases.

Fasten off leaving a long tail.

The heart should measure approximately:

3 inches (7.5 cm)

Step 9 – Attach the Heart

Center the heart on the front panel.

Position it approximately:

2 inches (5 cm)

below the top opening.

Sew around the entire heart securely.

Hide all yarn tails inside the pocket.

Step 10 – Shape the Organizer

Insert a folded towel or small pillow inside.

Lightly steam if your yarn allows.

Allow the organizer to dry while holding its rectangular shape.

This helps the pocket remain open and easier to use.

Step 11 – Optional Interior Divider

For extra organization:

Crochet a rectangle:

6¼ × 4 inches

Sew only the sides and bottom inside the organizer.

This creates two interior compartments.

Perfect for:

- Phone
- Wallet
- Charging cable
- Sunglasses

Step 12 – Optional Closure

If preferred, add:

- Magnetic snap
- Wooden button
- Crochet loop
- Decorative clasp

A closure helps keep items secure during travel.

Step 13 – Final Inspection

Check:

- Pocket seams
- Strap attachment
- Heart appliqué
- Top edge
- Metal ring security

Trim loose yarn.

Weave in all remaining ends.

Your organizer is now ready to use.

Customization Ideas

- 💕 Crochet initials onto the front
- 🌸 Add embroidered flowers
- 🦋 Sew tiny butterflies
- ★ Add decorative wooden buttons
- 🌻 Use pastel colors for spring
- 💙 Make one in denim blue
- ❤️ Create holiday-themed versions
- 🐻 Add cute animal appliqués for kids
- 🚗 Make matching organizers for both front seats

Care Instructions

- Hand wash with mild detergent
- Wash in cool water
- Do not bleach
- Lay flat to dry
- Do not tumble dry
- Avoid hanging while wet
- Reshape while drying
- Do not iron directly on the crochet fabric
