FINISHED SIZE

Approx.
18 cm wide
x
28 cm tall
(7 in x 11 in)



MATERIALS

- Worsted weight cotton yarn
 - White / Off White
 - Black / Dark Gray
 - Red
 - Green
- 3.0 mm crochet hook
- Yarn needle
- Scissors
- Stitch marker (optional)

ABBREVIATIONS (US TERMS)

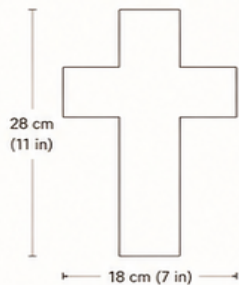
- ch = chain
- sc = single crochet
- hdc = half double crochet
- dc = double crochet
- tr = treble crochet
- sl st = slip stitch
- inc = increase (2 sc in same stitch)
- dec = decrease (sc 2 together)
- () = work in same stitch
- * = repeat

YOU WILL MAKE

A crochet cross wall hanging with a 3D Jesus face, crown of thorns, and roses.



CROSS BASE (Make 2 panels)



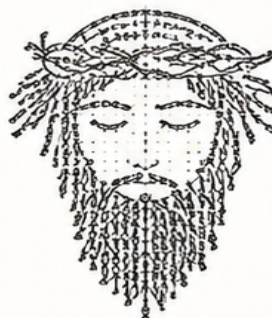
CROSS BASE PATTERN (Make 2)



- = chain (ch)
- x = single crochet (sc)
- ┐ = half double crochet (hdc)
- └ = double crochet (dc)
- ┘ = treble crochet (tr)
- = slip stitch (sl st)

Work in continuous rounds.
Do not join. Use a stitch marker to mark the first stitch of each round.

JESUS FACE (Make 1)



ROSE (Make 2)



- = chain
- ┐ = double crochet
- └ = treble crochet
- = slip stitch

LEAF (Make 4)



- = chain
- x = single crochet
- ┐ = half double crochet
- └ = double crochet
- = slip stitch

♥ STEP-BY-STEP INSTRUCTIONS ♥

1 MAKE 2 PANELS



Crochet two identical cross panels using the pattern above.

2 JOIN PANELS



Place the panels wrong sides together. Sc around the edges to join.

3 JESUS FACE



Crochet the face, crown of thorns and beard using the diagram as a guide.

4 ATTACH FACE



Sew the face piece to the center of the cross.

5 CROCHET ROSES



Make 2 roses following the diagram.

6 MAKE LEAVES



Crochet 4 leaves (2 for each side of the roses).

7 ATTACH FLOWERS



Sew the roses and leaves to each side of the cross.

8 HANG & ENJOY



Add a hanging loop at the top. Your wall hanging is ready! ♥

TIPS FOR SUCCESS

- Use tight stitches for a firm fabric.
- Weave in all ends securely.
- Pin pieces before sewing for perfect placement.
- Use fabric stiffener (optional) for a more structured look.



IDEAS & VARIATIONS

- Use beige yarn for a natural look.
- Add wooden beads to the hanging loop.
- Make a smaller version as a car hanging.



CARE INSTRUCTIONS

- Hand wash gently with mild soap.
- Lay flat to dry.
- Do not bleach.
- Do not iron.

Crochet Jesus Cross

The **Crochet Jesus Cross Wall Hanging** is a meaningful handmade project that combines traditional crochet with dimensional appliqué to create a beautiful representation of Jesus on the cross. Featuring a textured cross base, detailed face, crown of thorns, flowing beard, and decorative roses with leaves, this project makes a thoughtful gift or a special piece of Christian home décor.

Skill Level

Intermediate to Advanced

This project combines flat crochet, appliqué, embroidery, and assembly techniques.

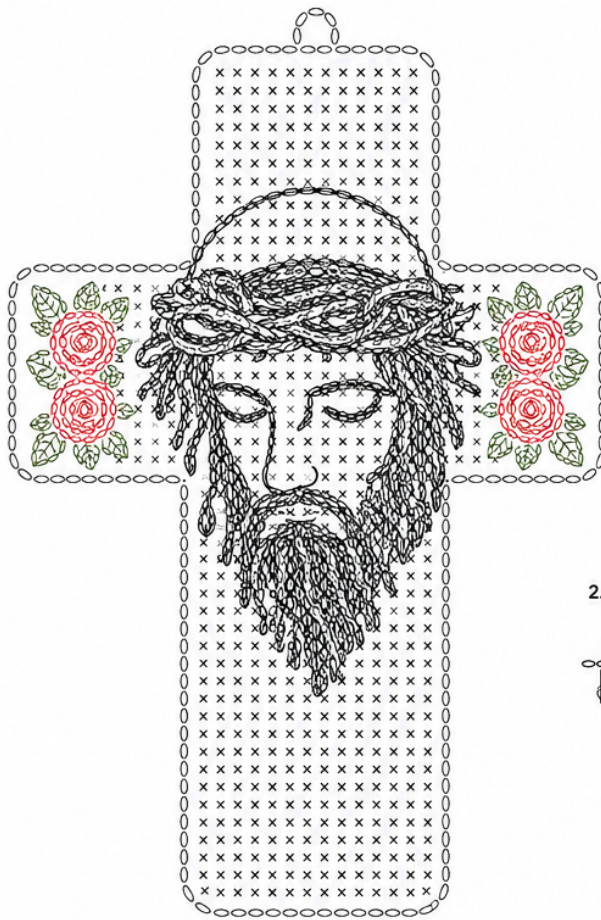
Finished Size

- Width: **18 cm (7 inches)**
- Height: **28 cm (11 inches)**

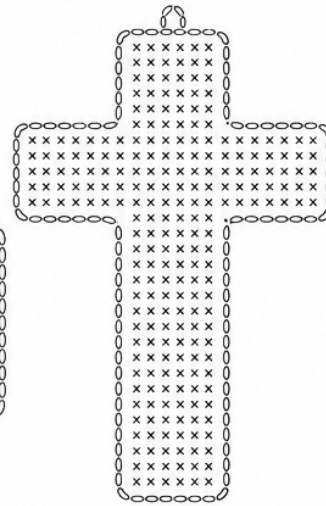
Materials

- Worsted weight cotton yarn
- White or Off-White
- Black
- Dark Gray
- Red
- Green
- 3.0 mm crochet hook
- Yarn needle
- Embroidery needle
- Stitch markers (optional)
- Scissors
- Fiberfill (optional for slight dimension)
- Fabric stiffener (optional)

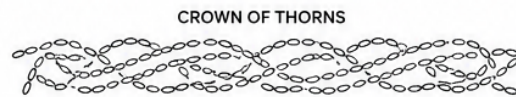
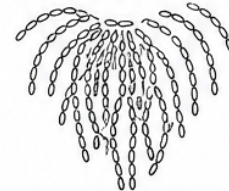
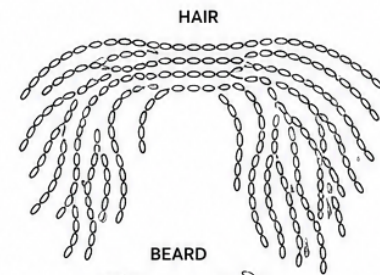
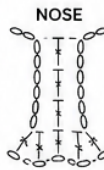
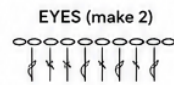
1. CROSS (BODY)

- chain (ch)
- slip stitch (sl st)
- × single crochet (sc)

- chain space

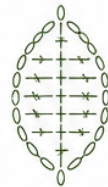
2. FACE (EMBROIDERY – TR SURFACE CROCHET)



3. ROSES (make 4)



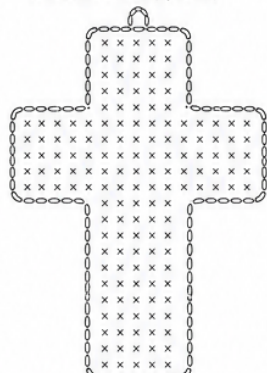
LEAF (make 8)



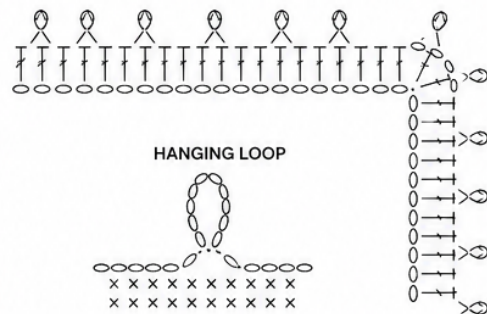
4. ASSEMBLY LAYOUT

BORDER (AROUND THE CROSS)



NOTES

- Work the cross body in continuous rounds or rows as shown in diagram 1.
- Use surface crochet (tr) or embroidery stitch to create the face, hair, beard and crown of thorns.
- Make 4 roses and 8 leaves. Sew them on both sides of the horizontal arms.
- Add a border around the entire cross for a clean finish.
- Create a chain loop at the top for hanging.

RECOMMENDED YARN & HOOK

- Medium weight cotton yarn
- Hook size: 3.0 mm – 4.0 mm
- Yarn needle for embroidery
- Scissors

Crochet Abbreviations (US Terms)

- ch – chain
- sl st – slip stitch
- sc – single crochet
- hdc – half double crochet
- dc – double crochet
- tr – treble crochet
- inc – increase
- dec – decrease
- st – stitch
- rep – repeat

Color Guide

- White – Cross base
- Black – Hair, beard, crown of thorns
- Dark Gray – Facial shading
- Red – Roses
- Green – Leaves

Step 1 – Crochet the Cross Base

Begin by crocheting the front panel of the cross.

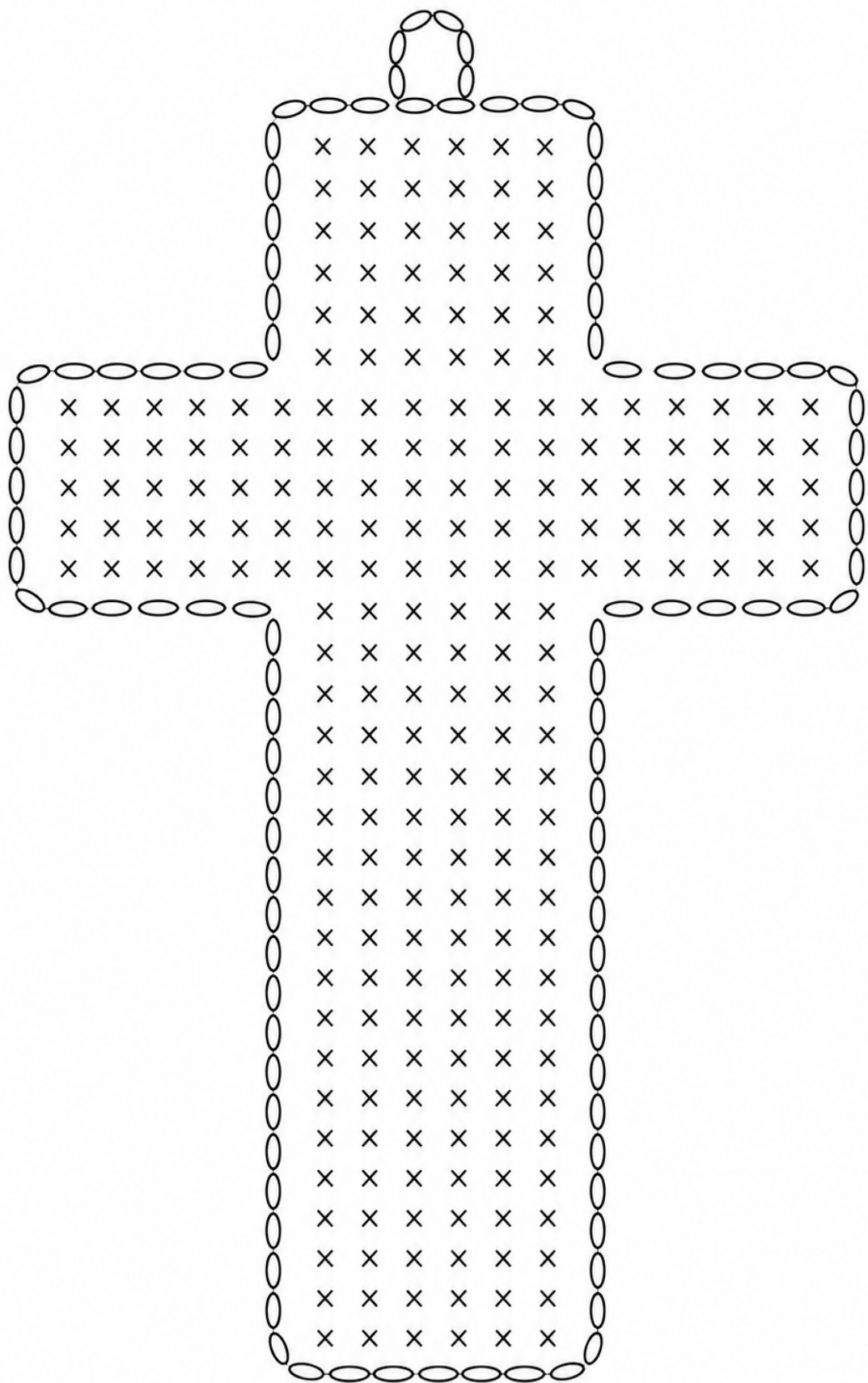
Work in rows using single crochet stitches to create a firm fabric.

Shape the horizontal arms by increasing the stitch count where necessary.

Maintain straight edges throughout the project.

Repeat the entire process to create a second identical cross panel.

Fasten off and weave in all yarn ends.



Step 2 – Join the Cross Panels

Place both cross pieces together with the wrong sides facing each other.

Join the panels using single crochet stitches around the entire edge.

Keep the stitches even for a clean border.

If desired, lightly stuff the cross before completely closing it.

Leave the top edge open until stuffing is complete.

Close the remaining opening with slip stitches.

Step 3 – Crochet the Face of Jesus

Crochet the facial base separately using light-colored yarn.

Shape the forehead, cheeks, and chin with gradual increases and decreases.

Embroider the closed eyes using black yarn.

Add subtle eyebrow details.

Use gray embroidery to create gentle facial shadows.

Fasten off securely.

Step 4 – Make the Hair and Beard

Using black yarn, crochet or attach strands for the hair.

Work the hair from the top downward in layers.

Create the beard separately using long textured strands.

Attach the mustache above the mouth.

Trim the yarn evenly if necessary.

Arrange the hair naturally around the face.

Step 5 – Create the Crown of Thorns

Using black or dark brown yarn, crochet a narrow twisted cord.

Wrap the cord into a circular crown.

Attach small short yarn strands to imitate thorns.

Position the crown across the forehead.

Secure it with invisible stitches.

Step 6 – Attach the Face

Center the completed face on the front of the cross.

Pin it in place before sewing.

Attach using small whip stitches around the edge.

Hide all yarn tails on the back.

Ensure the face remains perfectly centered.

Step 7 – Crochet the Roses

Using red yarn, crochet two spiral roses.

Roll each spiral tightly to form the flower.

Secure the base with several stitches.

Shape the petals evenly.

Steam lightly if necessary.

Set the flowers aside.

Step 8 – Crochet the Leaves

Using green yarn, crochet four leaves.

Shape each leaf with pointed ends.

Create visible center veins using surface embroidery if desired.

Fasten off and weave in all ends.

Press lightly.

Step 9 – Attach the Floral Decoration

Arrange one rose with two leaves on each side of the cross.

Pin before sewing.

Attach securely using matching thread or yarn.

Adjust the position until both sides appear balanced.

Step 10 – Add the Hanging Loop

Create a small chain loop using white yarn.

Attach it firmly to the top center of the cross.

Reinforce the attachment with several stitches.

Test the strength before hanging.

Step 11 – Finishing Touches

Inspect every seam and embroidery detail.

Trim any loose threads.

Steam lightly without flattening the textured details.

Apply fabric stiffener if a firmer wall hanging is preferred.

Allow everything to dry completely.

Helpful Tips

Use cotton yarn for better stitch definition.

Keep your crochet tension consistent throughout the project.

Pin all appliqué pieces before sewing permanently.

Use invisible stitches for a cleaner finish.

Lightly block the cross before adding the decorative elements.

Care Instructions

Hand wash gently with mild soap.

Do not bleach.

Lay flat to dry.

Do not wring.

Do not iron directly over the appliqué.

Store flat when not displayed.

Customization Ideas

Use cream or ivory yarn for a vintage appearance.

Frame the finished cross inside a wooden embroidery hoop.

Replace the roses with lilies or olive branches.

Add a decorative crochet border around the cross.

Personalize the back with an embroidered Bible verse or dedication.

Create a larger version using thicker cotton yarn and a larger hook.

The **Crochet Jesus Cross Wall Hanging** is a beautiful expression of faith, handcrafted with care and meaningful details.
