

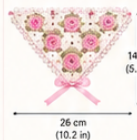


♥ CROCHET ♥ Rose Garden CAT BANDANA

A sweet and elegant crochet bandana
with little roses and pearl edging.
Perfect for picnics, photos and everyday cuteness! ♥

FINISHED SIZE

One size fits most cats
Neck circumference:
20-30 cm
(7.9-11.8 in)
(Adjust ribbon for fit)



MATERIALS

- Cotton yarn (light worsted)
- Pink (roses)
- Cream (main color)
- Light green (leaves)
- White (edging)
- Pearl beads (6 mm)
- Satin ribbon (50 cm)
- Yarn needle
- Scissors

TOOLS

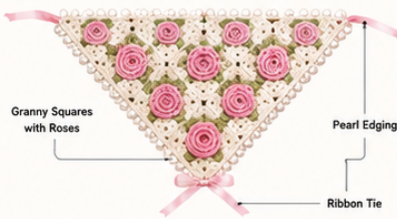
- 2.5 mm crochet hook
- Scissors
- Yarn needle
- Stitch markers
- Measuring tape

YOU WILL MAKE

A crochet bandana
made of granny
squares with
3D roses, pearl
edging and a
ribbon tie.

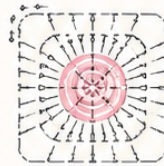


BANDANA CONSTRUCTION



GRANNY SQUARE (with 3D Rose)

Make 13 squares



- = chain (ch)
- = slip stitch (sl st)
- × = single crochet (sc)
- ⌈ = double crochet (dc)
- ⌋ = treble crochet (tr)
- () = work in same stitch
- [] = repeat instructions
- Pink - Rose
- Cream - Square
- Green - Leaves

3D ROSE (center)

Make 13

Ch 21.
Sc in 2nd ch from hook
and in each ch across.
Roll into a rose and
sew the base.



LEAVES (make 2 per square)

Ch 6.
Dc, hdc, sc, sl st
in next 4 sts.
Fasten off.



♥ STEP-BY-STEP ♥

1. MAKE SQUARES



Make 13 granny squares
with 3D roses and leaves.

2. JOIN SQUARES



Arrange in a triangle
(1-2-3-3 pattern). Join
with slip stitch or whip stitch.

3. EDGE (ROUND 1)



Join white yarn. Ch 1, sc
around the entire edge
of the bandana.

4. EDGE (ROUND 2)



Ch 3, skip 1 st, sc in next st,
repeat around to create
a picot effect.

5. ADD PEARLS



Attach pearls to each picot,
using a needle and thread.
Knot securely.

6. RIBBON HOLES



Weave ribbon through
the side spaces at the
top corners.

ABBREVIATIONS (US TERMS)

- ch = chain
- sl st = slip stitch
- sc = single crochet
- hdc = half double crochet
- dc = double crochet
- tr = treble crochet
- () = work in same stitch
- [] = repeat

7. ATTACH RIBBON



Tie a satin ribbon on the
each side.

8. ADJUST FIT



Tie a satin ribbon on
each side.

9. ADJUST FIT



Adjust the ribbon to fit
your cat comfortably.

10. ALL DONE!



Your cat is ready
for a lovely picnic! ♥

11. ENJOY!

YARN SUGGESTION

Use 100% cotton yarn for best
shape and stitch definition.

TIPS FOR SUCCESS

- ♥ Use cotton yarn for durability
and stitch definition.
- ♥ Block granny squares gently
for a neat finish.
- ♥ Secure pearls tightly with
strong thread.

IDEAS & VARIATIONS

- ♥ Make more roses for a fuller look.
- ♥ Use pastel or vibrant colors.
- ♥ Add a small charm to
the ribbon ends.

CARE INSTRUCTIONS

- Hand wash gently
in cold water.
- Lay flat to dry.
- Do not bleach.
- Do not iron pearls.

Crochet Rose Garden Cat Bandana

Dress your feline friend in a charming handmade accessory with this elegant **Crochet Rose Garden Cat Bandana**. Featuring delicate granny squares with dimensional roses, soft green leaves, pearl edging, and satin ribbon ties, this bandana is perfect for photo shoots, birthdays, holidays, or everyday cuteness. This detailed tutorial walks you through every step so even confident beginners can complete the project successfully.

Finished Size

The finished bandana is designed to fit most adult cats.

- Width: 10.2 inches (26 cm)
- Height: 5.5 inches (14 cm)
- Neck Circumference: Adjustable from 7.9–11.8 inches (20–30 cm) using ribbon ties

The size can easily be adjusted by adding or removing granny squares.

Skill Level

- Beginner to Intermediate

Materials

Yarn

Use lightweight cotton yarn for the best stitch definition.

- Cream – 90 g
- Pink – 40 g
- Light Pink – 25 g
- Sage Green – 20 g
- White – 20 g

Additional Supplies

- 2.5 mm crochet hook
- Yarn needle
- Stitch markers
- Scissors
- 6 mm pearl beads (approximately 55–70)
- Satin ribbon (20 inches / 50 cm)
- Sewing needle
- Matching sewing thread

Crochet Abbreviations (US Terms)

- ch = chain
- sl st = slip stitch
- sc = single crochet
- hdc = half double crochet
- dc = double crochet
- tr = treble crochet
- st = stitch
- sp = space
- rep = repeat

H2 – Step 1: Make the 3D Crochet Roses

Each granny square features one dimensional rose.

Make **13 roses**.

Foundation

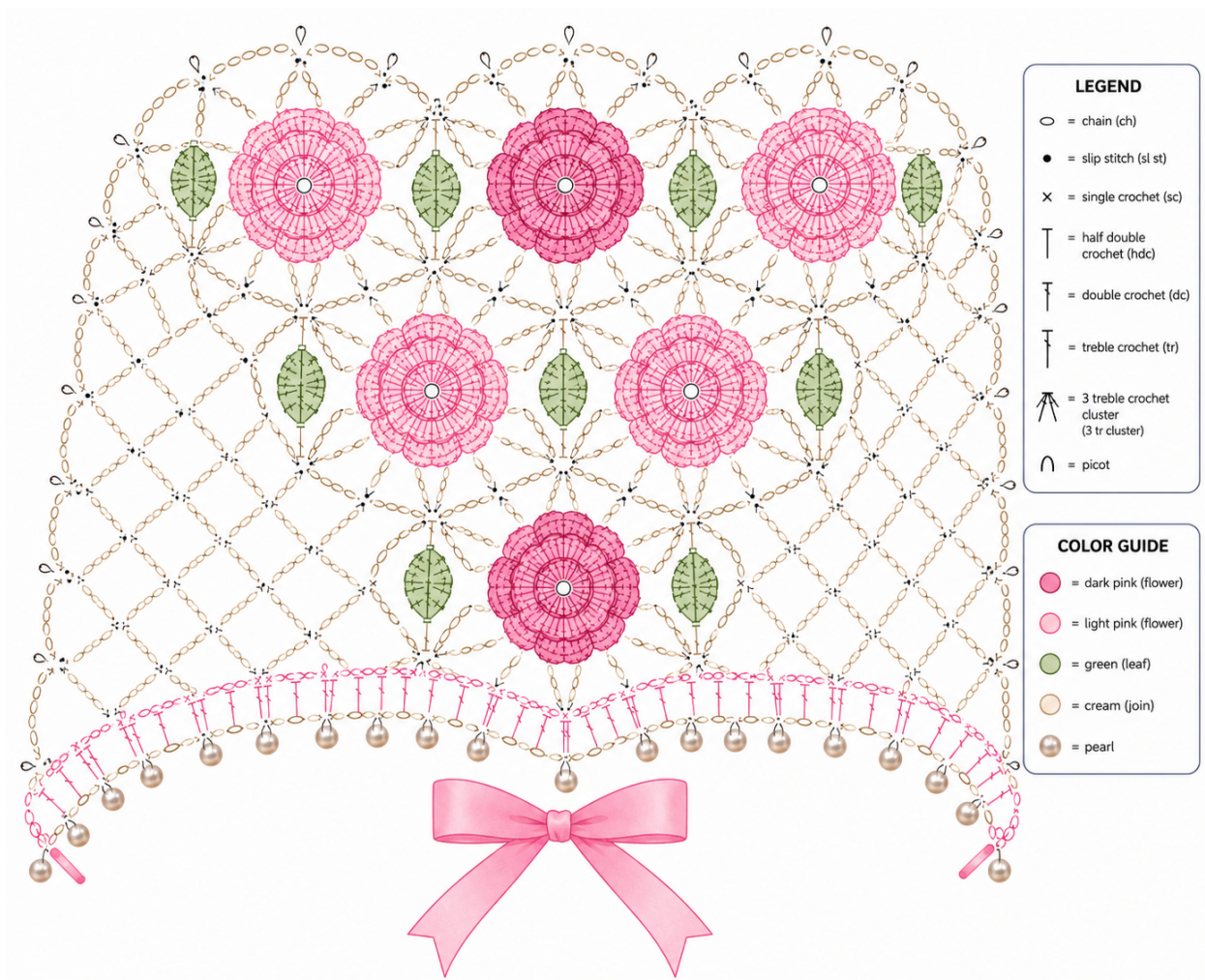
Ch 21.

Row 1

Work 1 sc into the second chain from hook.

Continue 1 sc across every chain.

Turn.



Row 2

Work:

(2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) into selected stitches to create petals.

Increase gradually toward the center.

The strip should naturally curl.

Form the Rose

Beginning with the smallest end:

Roll the strip tightly.

Continue wrapping loosely toward the outer petals.

Shape into a realistic blooming rose.

Secure the bottom using several stitches with matching yarn.

Each finished rose measures approximately:

- 1.2 inches (3 cm)

Set aside all 13 roses.

H2 – Step 2: Crochet the Leaves

Each square uses two leaves.

Make **26 leaves**.

Foundation

Ch 6.

Work:

- sc
- hdc
- dc
- hdc
- sc

around the chain.

Fasten off.

Shape the leaf gently.

Each leaf should measure approximately:

- 1 inch (2.5 cm)

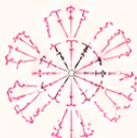

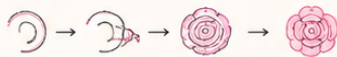
Único – ajustável com a fita

1. MOTIVO FLOR (FAZER 7 ROSAS)

Cor: rosa escuro



- 1) Anel mágico, 12 pb. [12]
 - 2) (aum) 12x. [24]
 - 3) (1 pb, aum) 12x. [36]
 - 4) (2 pb, aum) 12x. [48]
 - 5) (3 pb, aum) 12x. [60]
- Arremate deixando fio para costurar e enrolar as pétalas da rosa.



2. MOTIVO FOLHA (FAZER 14)

Cor: verde folha



- Corr. inicial: 7 corr.
- 1) A partir da 2ª corr. da agulha:
1 mpa, 1 pa, 2 pad, 1 pa, 1 mpa, 1 pbx.
- Arremate deixando fio para costurar. Dobre levemente ao meio para formar a folha.

4. BORDA COM PÉROLAS

Cor: rosa claro

Trabalhe ao redor de toda a borda da touca.



MATERIAIS

- Fio de algodão nas cores:
 - Rosa escuro
 - Rosa claro
 - Verde folha
 - Creme / off white
- Agulha de crochê 2,5 mm
- Pérolas (6 mm)
- Fita de cetim rosa (cerca de 60 cm)
- Agulha de tapeçaria
- Tesoura

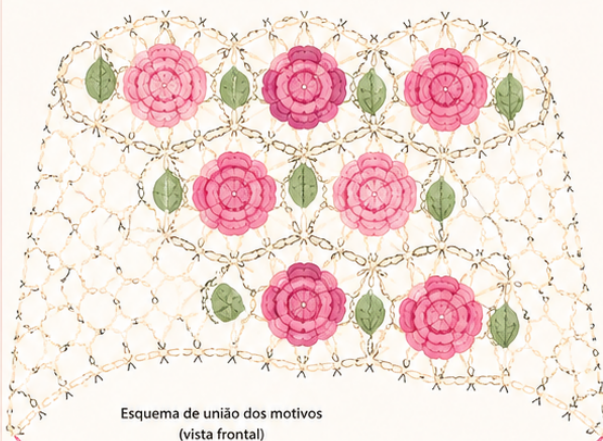
ABREVIÇÕES

- corr. = correntinha
 pbx = ponto baixíssimo
 pb = ponto baixo
 pa = ponto alto
 pad = ponto alto duplo
 mpa = meio ponto alto
 aum = aumento (2 pb no mesmo ponto)
 () = repetir
 [] = total de pontos

3. CAPA (UNIÃO DOS MOTIVOS)

Cor: principal: creme / off white

Monte 3 carreiras de motivos como no esquema.



Esquema de união dos motivos (vista frontal)

Borda inferior

LEGENDA

- o = corr.
 • = pbx
 x = pb
 T = pa
 T = pad
 ● = rosa (flor)
 ● = verde (folha)
 ○ = creme (união)

5. FITA

Costure a fita de cetim rosa nas pontas da borda inferior.

Amarre em um laço sob o queixo do pet.



DICAS

- Use fio de algodão para melhor acabamento.
- Ajuste o tamanho da touca conforme a cabeça do pet.
- As pérolas são aplicadas na 2ª carreira da borda.



CORES SUGERIDAS



CUIDADOS

Lavar à mão com sabão neutro. Secar à sombra.



H2 – Step 3: Crochet the Granny Squares

Create **13 identical granny squares**.

Center

Using pink yarn:

Magic Ring.

Round 1

12 dc into ring.

Join.

Round 2

Switch to cream.

Create corners using:

(2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc)

Continue around.

Round 3

Work traditional granny clusters.

Increase only at corners.

Round 4

Continue until square measures:

- 2.3 x 2.3 inches (6 x 6 cm)

Fasten off.

Block lightly.

H2 – Step 4: Attach Roses and Leaves

Place one rose in the center of each square.

Arrange two leaves beneath each flower.

Sew securely by hand.

Hide all yarn tails.

The flowers should appear slightly raised for a beautiful three-dimensional effect.

H2 – Step 5: Arrange the Triangle Layout

Lay the squares out in this order:

- Row 1: 1 square
- Row 2: 2 squares
- Row 3: 3 squares
- Row 4: 4 squares
- Row 5: 3 squares

Total:

13 granny squares.

Check spacing before joining.

H2 – Step 6: Join the Squares

Using cream yarn.

Join squares with either:

Slip Stitch Join

or

Whip Stitch

Work carefully through corresponding stitches.

Maintain even tension.

After joining, the bandana should form a neat triangle.

Press lightly if needed.

H2 – Step 7: Crochet Border – Round One

Attach cream yarn to any corner.

Work:

1 sc in every stitch.

At corners:

(sc, ch 2, sc)

Continue around entire bandana.

Join with slip stitch.

H2 – Step 8: Crochet Decorative Border – Round Two

Create a delicate scalloped edging.

Work:

Ch 3

Skip 1 stitch

Sc into next stitch

Repeat around.

On every chain space create:

5 dc shell

Skip next stitch.

Repeat around.

The border should create soft decorative waves.

H2 – Step 9: Add Pearl Edging

Using sewing thread.

Attach one pearl bead to every picot or shell point.

Space beads evenly.

Approximately:

55–70 pearls

Tie secure knots after every few beads.

Hide thread ends carefully.

The pearl trim creates an elegant vintage finish.

H2 – Step 10: Create Ribbon Openings

Near the upper corners:

Locate the side chain spaces.

Weave ribbon through these openings.

If desired, reinforce openings with one additional row of sc.

H2 – Step 11: Attach Satin Ribbon

Cut satin ribbon:

20 inches (50 cm)

Thread ribbon through both upper corners.

Tie decorative bows.

Seal ribbon ends carefully with a lighter or fabric sealant to prevent fraying.

H2 – Step 12: Fit the Bandana

Place the bandana around your cat's neck.

Tie the ribbon comfortably.

The bandana should rest loosely without restricting movement.

Always ensure you can easily slide two fingers beneath the ribbon.

Never tie too tightly.

H2 – Step 13: Final Blocking

Pin the finished bandana into shape.

Ensure:

- Straight upper edge
- Even scallops
- Flat granny squares
- Centered roses

Lightly steam or mist with water.

Allow to dry completely.

Blocking enhances stitch definition and gives the project a polished finish.

Optional Customizations

-  Use lavender roses
-  Make white roses for weddings
-  Add tiny embroidered flowers
-  Add miniature butterflies
-  Sew small crystal beads into flower centers
-  Create a matching leash charm
-  Make a larger version for small dogs
-  Add extra granny squares for larger pets

Care Instructions

- Hand wash only
- Cold water

- Mild detergent
- Do not bleach
- Lay flat to dry
- Do not wring
- Avoid ironing directly over pearls
- Store flat to preserve the shape of the roses
