STEP-BY-STEP PATTERN

A cute and delicate scarf with
sweet cats and blooming flowers!

FINISHED SIZE

Width: 12 cm
(4.7 in)
Length: 100–110 cm
(39–43 in)

* Easily adjustable
by adding or
removing motifs.



MATERIALS

- Cotton yarn
(DK / light worsted)
 - Green, Cream,
Gray, Pink, Brown,
Yellow
- 2.5 mm (US C/2)
crochet hook
- Yarn needle
- Scissors

ABBREVIATIONS (US TERMS)

ch = chain
sl st = slip stitch
sc = single crochet
dc = double crochet
hdc = half double crochet
tr = treble crochet
dc2tog = double crochet
2 together
() = work in same stitch
* = repeat

CROCHET DIAGRAM



Repeat
motif
vertically

STITCH LEGEND

- = chain (ch)
• = slip stitch (sl st)
x = single crochet (sc)
T = half double crochet (hdc)
f = double crochet (dc)
tr = treble crochet (tr)
△ = double crochet 2 together (dc2tog)
() = work in same stitch
- ★ = repeat

COLOR GUIDE

- Green (main)
- Cream (cat body & flowers)
- Gray (cat patches)
- Pink (ears & nose)
- Brown (branches)
- Yellow (flower center)
- Green (leaves)

🐾 STEP-BY-STEP INSTRUCTIONS (Each motif) 🐾

1 CAT BODY



Start with the cat body
using the diagram.
Change colors to create
the ears, patches and
tail.

2 CAT FACE



Add eyes (with yarn
or embroidery),
whiskers and nose.

3 FLOWER



Crochet the flower
following the flower
diagram.
Add yellow center.

4 LEAVES & BRANCH



Make leaves in green
and branches in brown.
Attach around
the flower.

5 JOIN ELEMENTS



Arrange and attach
the cat, flower, leaves
and branches as
shown in the diagram.

6 LACE BACKGROUND



Work the lace stitches
around all elements
to form the openwork
background.

7 BORDER



Work the scalloped
edge around the
entire motif.

8 REPEAT



Repeat the motif
vertically until your
scarf reaches the
desired length.

TIPS FOR SUCCESS

- Use cotton yarn for a
well-defined lace.
- Block your scarf gently
to open the lace.
- Weave in all ends neatly.
- Take your time with the
embroidery details!



IDEAS & VARIATIONS

- Use pastel colors for a
soft look.
- Add more flowers or
leave out the branches.
- Make a matching
headband or bag!



CARE INSTRUCTIONS

- Hand wash gently
with mild soap.
- Lay flat to dry.
- Do not bleach.
- Do not iron.
- Do not wring.

Crochet Cat Scarf Pattern

The **Crochet Cat & Blossom Scarf** is a charming lace accessory that combines delicate openwork with adorable crochet cat motifs, blooming flowers, leafy branches, and a soft scalloped border. This elegant project is ideal for spring and summer, making a thoughtful handmade gift for cat lovers or a beautiful addition to your own wardrobe.

Skill Level

Intermediate

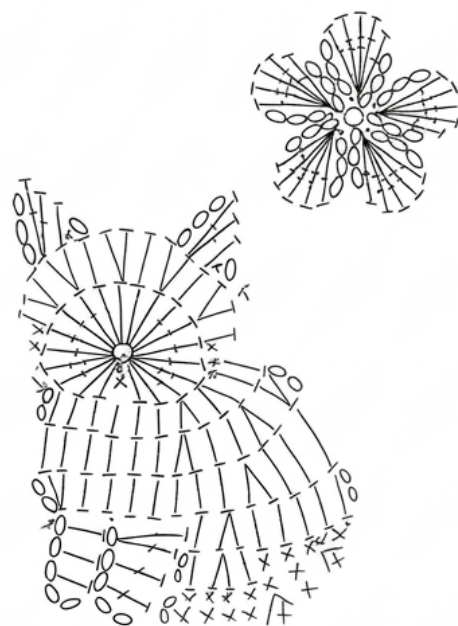
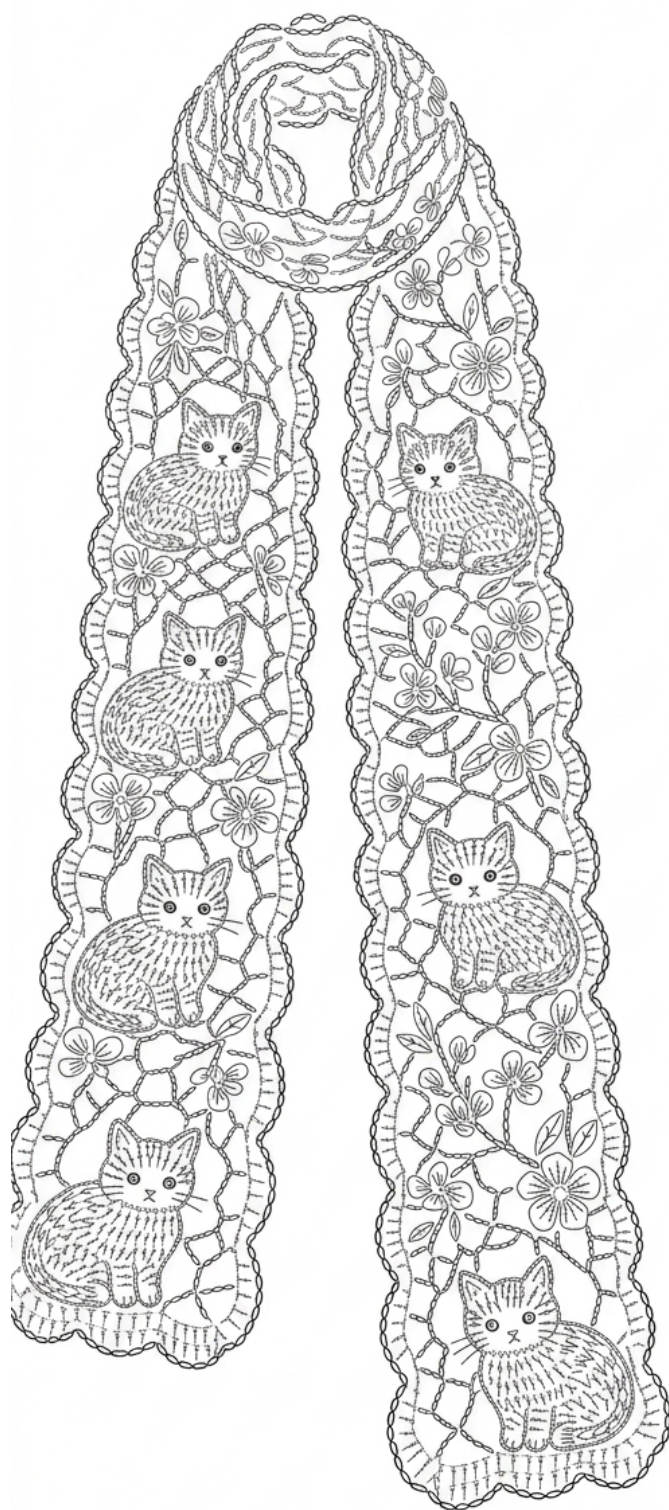
This project is suitable for crocheters who are comfortable working with lace stitches, appliqués, and joining individual motifs.

Finished Size

- Width: Approximately **12 cm (4.7 inches)**
- Length: **100–110 cm (39–43 inches)**
- Easily adjustable by repeating additional lace motifs.

Materials

- DK or Light Worsted cotton yarn
- Main Color: Sage Green
- Cream
- Light Gray
- Dark Gray
- Pink
- Brown
- Yellow
- Olive Green
- Crochet Hook: **2.5 mm (US C/2)**
- Yarn needle
- Stitch markers
- Small embroidery needle
- Scissors



Crochet Abbreviations (US Terms)

- ch – chain
- sl st – slip stitch
- sc – single crochet
- hdc – half double crochet
- dc – double crochet
- tr – treble crochet
- dc2tog – double crochet two together
- sp – space
- st – stitch
- rep – repeat

Color Guide

- Sage Green – lace background
- Cream – cat body and flowers
- Light Gray – cat patches
- Dark Gray – ears and tail
- Pink – ears and nose
- Brown – tree branches
- Olive Green – leaves
- Yellow – flower centers

Step 1 – Crochet the Cat Body

Begin by crocheting the cat body following the central motif pattern.

Start from the lower body using cream yarn.

Gradually shape the rounded body using increases.

Change to gray where the patches appear.

Finish by crocheting the tail separately and sewing it onto the body.

Fasten off and weave in all yarn ends neatly.

Step 2 – Make the Cat Face

Crochet the head as a separate piece.

Embroider the eyes using black yarn.

Add a small pink triangular nose.

Create the whiskers with embroidery thread.

Sew the head securely onto the body.

Lightly stuff the head if a slight three-dimensional effect is desired.

Step 3 – Crochet the Flowers

Make several five-petal flowers.

Begin each flower with a magic ring.

Work petals using double crochet and chain spaces.

Create yellow French-knot style centers using yarn embroidery.

Make enough flowers for every scarf section.

Block the flowers before assembly.

Step 4 – Make the Leaves and Branches

Crochet small pointed leaves in olive green.

Create thin branches using brown chains covered with slip stitches.

Arrange two or three leaves per branch.

Steam lightly if necessary.

Prepare enough branches for every repeating motif.

Step 5 – Join the Decorative Elements

Arrange the cat, flowers, branches, and leaves according to your preferred layout.

Pin each element before attaching.

Sew all pieces securely using matching sewing thread or yarn.

Hide every yarn tail on the back.

Ensure every motif remains flat before continuing.

Step 6 – Crochet the Lace Background

Using sage green yarn, begin the openwork mesh.

Work chain loops connected with single crochet and double crochet groups.

Continue building the lace around each decorative motif.

Maintain even tension throughout the project.

Keep each opening symmetrical for a balanced appearance.

Repeat until the entire scarf width is completed.

Step 7 – Add the Decorative Border

Work a scalloped edging around both long sides.

Use shells made from double crochet stitches.

Finish each corner with an extra shell for a rounded appearance.

Keep the border flexible without pulling the lace.

Fasten off and weave in all remaining ends.

Step 8 – Repeat the Pattern

Continue repeating the complete lace motif vertically.

Attach additional cats, flowers, and branches at regular intervals.

Maintain identical spacing between each motif.

Continue until the scarf reaches approximately 100–110 cm (39–43 inches), or your preferred length.

Blocking

Wash the scarf gently in lukewarm water.

Pin it onto blocking mats.

Stretch the lace evenly to open the stitches.

Allow it to dry completely before removing the pins.

Blocking gives the lace its elegant finished appearance.

Finishing

Inspect every seam and embroidered detail.

Trim any loose threads.

Steam lightly if necessary.

Your **Crochet Cat & Blossom Scarf** is now complete and ready to wear.

Helpful Tips

Use mercerized cotton yarn for crisp lace definition.

Keep consistent stitch tension throughout every repeat.

Block every decorative motif before joining for easier assembly.

Use stitch markers to maintain the lace repeat.

Leave long yarn tails when attaching appliqués for stronger seams.

Care Instructions

Hand wash in cool water using mild detergent.

Do not bleach.

Lay flat to dry.

Do not wring.

Steam lightly if necessary.

Store folded instead of hanging to preserve the lace shape.

Customization Ideas

Create a longer scarf by adding extra motif repeats.

Use pastel shades for a softer spring look.

Replace the cats with other animal appliqués.

Add small crochet butterflies or birds between the flowers.

Sew tiny pearl beads into the flower centers.

Create a matching headband, tote bag, or shawl using the same lace motif.
